Pedestrian Safety

- Adults accompany children in the cross walk.
- Walk when crossing the street.
- Stop at the curb and look left, look right, and then left again.
- Watch and listen for turning vehicles and those you may not be able to see.
- At traffic lights, wait for the green light or WALK sign.
- Listen for sirens. Wait to cross the street when an emergency vehicle is coming with sirens on, even if the walk sign is lit and the light is green.
- Watch for cars backing out of driveways.
- Obey crossing guard signals.
- Playing in or near streets is dangerous.
- If there are no sidewalks, walk on the left side of the road, facing traffic. Stay as far off the road as possible.
