1ST FIVE

Dage

1st Five care coordinators arrange services for families with children 0-5 years of age. 1st Five staff understand that the health and well-being of family members directly impacts the health of an infant or young child. Please request a referral to 1st Five through your local health care provider.

CARE FOR KIDS PROGRAM

The Care for Kids Program serves all Medicaid/Title 19 individuals under the age of 21. The focus is to link individuals to medical, dental, vision and other medical services while connecting families to community resources that help improve the health and well being of individuals in the Care for Kids program.

COMMUNITY HOME VISITING PROGRAM

The Community Home Visiting Program provides nursing visits to pregnant and parenting women living in Polk County. Registered nurses and dieticians provide: Prenatal and postpartum health education, child development screening and education, prenatal depression screening and referral, referrals to community resources, nutrition counseling, family planning counseling, interpretation services available upon request.

COMMUNITY VOICES

Community Voices Interpretation Services specializes in interpretation and translation. Our interpreters speak more than 20 languages and dialects, including Spanish, Nepali, Burmese, Chin, Karen, Swahili and Arabic. Our interpreters serve as a gateway for non-English speaking clients, helping them access available services and resources. Our staff is also available to work with organizations and businesses to improve client satisfaction, workflow efficiencies and billing opportunities as they work with clients who have communication barriers.

VNS of Iowa Programs (continued)

HEALTHY START & EMPOWERMENT FAMILY SUPPORT PROJECTS

Healthy Start & Empowerment provides case management services to families in need in Polk County who are pregnant or have a child up to the age of six. Case management services include: home visits, prenatal, postpartum and parenting education, child development screening and education, prenatal depression screening and referral, support groups, referrals to community resources and support in accessing services, Referrals can be made by a physician, social worker, family member, friend, or as a self-referral.

HOME CARE (VNS HOME CARE)

VNS Home Care provides comprehensive services to meet clients' health care needs. Our services assist clients in regaining independence and abilities as they recover from an illness, injury or medical condition.

IOWA FAMILY SUPPORT NETWORK (IFSN)

lowa Family Support Network provides a coordinated intake and referral system to assist families, child healthcare providers, and other professionals. IFSN serves families with a variety of parenting and developmental needs and provides links to resources. IFSN also manages the Children at Home program which provides financial assistance to parents of children with disabilities.

Families, child healthcare providers, and other professionals can make referrals and obtain information about family support services, group based services, Children at Home, IDEA Part C early intervention known as Early ACCESS, and other community support in lowa.

I-SMILE™

I-Smile[™] provides oral health screenings; oral health education; nutrition education relating to oral health; fluoride varnish application; and a referral to a dentist for comprehensive dental needs for pregnant woman and children under the age of 21.

MATERNAL CHILD HEALTH OUTREACH

Maternal Child Health Outreach has outreach specialists who assist uninsured families, children and pregnant women in obtaining hawk-i, Medicaid or other health care coverage and finding a doctor and dentist. Outreach specialists speak Spanish and English.

NAVIGATOR PROGRAM (Health Insurance Marketplace)

The new Health Insurance Marketplace helps uninsured people find health coverage. Our dedicated navigators are trained and licensed by the lowa Insurance Division to help you understand your health coverage options. We then help you enroll in a Marketplace plan that meets your needs and fits your budget.

NURSE FAMILY PARTNERSHIP

The Nurse Family Partership matches first-time parents with a nurse home visitor who provides ongoing education and support beginning during the mother's pregnancy and continuing until the child turns two years old.

PLAY AND LEARN

Play and Learn designs free activities for caregivers to play and learn with their children ages 0 to 8 years old, while connecting with other caregivers. Play ideas are given to caregivers to help get kids ready and stay ready for school. Every child receives a book and a healthy snack at each session.

SENIOR COMPANION PROGRAM

The Senior Companion Program provides service to adults who would benefit from extra social/emotional support or those needing local transportation or respite care on a regular weekly basis.

The program recruits seniors aged 55 or older to serve people in their neighborhood/community while earning a tax-free hourly stipend, mileage reimbursement, paid holidays and other benefits. This extra income does not decrease any benefits the Senior Companion may be receiving including social security disability, food stamps or any other assistance program. Senior Companions serve between 15 and 40 hours a week.

VNS of Iowa Programs (continued)

STORK'S NEST

Stork's Nest is an educational incentive program. Pregnant women who live in Polk County and who meet program income guidelines may enroll in the Stork's Nest. Participants earn points for healthy behaviors such as keeping medical appointments, WIC participation, breast feeding, and school attendance. These points are redeemed for needed baby items such as diapers, clothing, strollers, cribs and car seats. Parenting and prenatal classes are available.

STORYBOOK PROJECT OF IOWA

The Storybook Project of Iowa keeps incarcerated parents and their children connected through reading. Once a month, parents and grandmothers select one book per child and read to their children/grandchildren through a digital voice recorder with the assistance of a trained volunteer. The stories are burnt onto a CD and mailed, along with the book, to the child. The mission is to strengthen the bond between parent and child during incarceration while promoting reading and literacy.

TRANSPORTATION SERVICES

VNS of lowa offers transportation for individuals and families living in Polk County who meet the following criteria and/or enroll in the following services:

- Children under age 21 and pregnant women enrolled in Fee-For-Service Medicaid/Title XIX (not assigned to an MCO) – Transportation to medical, dental, and mental health appointments;
- Healthy Start & Empowerment participants Transportation may be provided to support/educational groups and other appointments and services as indicated by their case plans

VNS OF IOWA WELLNESS

VNS of Iowa Wellness offers a variety of screenings and immunizations. Services offered include:

- On-site flu clinics for businesses, organizations and child care centers
- On-site employee wellness/biometric screenings. Blood profiles and physical values are provided, which employees can use to identify their risk factors for disease. Employers receive aggregate reports to help enhance their wellness program.
- TB tests
- · Paternity tests
- · Other immunizations as requested


